DECISION ON REQUEST FOR REVOCATION

The Hearing Committee met on January 12, 2022, February 18, 2022, and March 14, 2022 to consider a Request for Revocation of Registration from Nickolas Jollimore, Pharmacy Technician.

The Hearing Committee carefully reviewed all information received from the Nova Scotia College of Pharmacists, including a Request for Revocation of Registration signed by Nickolas Jollimore on December 15, 2021 and the consent of the Registrar to the Request for Revocation. The Hearing Committee notes that Nickolas Jollimore admitted to removing drugs from Cochrane's Pharmasave, Wolfville, Nova Scotia, for his own misuse and purpose without authorization or a valid prescription.

After deliberation the Hearing Committee has decided pursuant to Regulation 77 of the Registration, Licensing and Professional Accountability Regulations made under the *Pharmacy Act*, R.S.N.S. 2011, c. 11, to accept Nickolas Jollimore's request to revoke his registration.

Accordingly, the license registration of Nickolas Jollimore is hereby revoked.
