Re: Update: Requirements for Sale of Single Ingredient Ephedrine and Pseudoephedrine.

As a follow-up to the NSCP's <u>Professional Notice in February 2024</u>, please be advised that Health Canada has issued an <u>Interim Order Concerning the Sale of Certain Natural Health Products Containing Ephedrine or</u> <u>Pseudoephedrine as a single ingredient that will be in effect until May 17, 2025</u>.

What does this interim order mean for pharmacies?

This order means that products containing ephedrine or pseudoephedrine as a **single ingredient**:

- can only be sold in a pharmacy,
- can only be sold to an individual after a pharmacist has determined that the medication is appropriate,
- must be located in an area in the pharmacy where there is no opportunity for self-selection.

Essentially, the conditions for sale are the same as for products that are included as part of schedule 2 of the NAPRA drug schedules.

Does this apply to all products containing these ingredients?

No, this order applies only to products that contain ephedrine or pseudoephedrine as a **single ingredient** or in combination with each other.

How long will this order be in place?

This order will be in place until May 17, 2025
