Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible to apply, you must:

- ✓ Have an IELTS (Academic) score of 7 or OET (Pharmacy) score of B.
- ✓ Be in good standing with the Jordan Pharmacy Association (JPA) or not be the subject of any complaints or unresolved matters that call into question your capacity to practice as a pharmacist.
- ✓ Have practiced sufficient direct patient care pharmacy within the last two (2) years to maintain your capacity to practice competently and ethically.
- ✓ Have graduated from one of the JPLP recognized pharmacy training programs.
