Re:	Critical Use of PPE During Third Wave

With case numbers rising and community transmission present in the province, all pharmacy practitioners who are providing direct patient care within 6 ft (including immunizers) should be using the full range of personal protective equipment (PPE) available to them. This includes both a medical/procedure face mask and a face shield.

There have been recent COVID-19 exposures at pharmacies in Nova Scotia. To minimize your assessed risk of exposure by Public Health, and to keep you safe, you should wear both a medical/procedure face mask and face shield when available.
