Re:	Changes to MAiD Legislation

On March 17, 2021, changes were made to Canada's MAiD legislation. Information on the specific changes that came into force with this new legislation is available on the <u>Department of Justice website</u>. Please note that changes have been made to:

- Eligibility criteria
- Procedural safeguards
- Final consent requirements
- The data collection and monitoring regime
