Re:	Practice Setting Approved by Council

One of the circumstances in which a pharmacist is authorized to prescribe a Schedule I drug is, "in a practice setting approved by Council—such as a hospital, a home for special care or a multi-disciplinary environment—where collaborative relationships or appropriate protocols are established" (<u>Pharmacist Drug Prescribing</u> <u>Regulations, s. 3 (f)</u>). At its most recent meeting, Council approved an application for an additional pharmacist for this category of prescribing.

Practice Setting

IWK Health Centre Hematology/Oncology Department, within the formal Collaborative Practice Agreement between the IWK and the specified pharmacists.
